95% Design Documents and probable budget were submitted on August 19, 2021. Engineering services are on hold pending approved amendment for additional services. In June 2022, NFWF has awarded \$5.4 million with TPCG match. TBS submitted a proposal in October 2022 and a revised proposal in April 2023 to include revised permit applications, finalize construction documents and prepare ROW documents utilizing the NFWF funds to construct the Lake Chien portion of the project. TPCG continues to seek funding for required construction administration costs. Environmental permitting coordination is ongoing. DNR has requested additional information related to the structure alignment. TBS to coordinate with the parish on response and has requested a planning meeting with the parish.
