

Subject: Emergency Levee work on Bayou Black (Seg 2 of MTG Western Tie In)

### Michelle,

This morning I spoke to Parish President Dove and he concurs with starting the emergency levee repair & rehabilitation work in the Gibson Bayou Black area. The main area that work will be done on is about 1.3 miles of levee from Gator Court (at Parish Pump Station) westward to Elliot Jones Canal. This area between the Elliot Jones and the Hanson Canal is known as Segment 2 of the Morganza to the Gulf (MTG) Western Tie In. The two main consultants working on this effort on behalf of TLCD and TPCG will be Joe Chauvin (GIS) and Ben Elliot (Delta Coast). Joe Chauvin will inspect the Geraldine Road levee and let us know his recommendation by early next week. Being we are "pulling the trigger" on this, this is a summary of our efforts:

- The Commandeering Order for the ROW needed in the 1.3 mile section of Seg 2 of the MTG Western Tie In has been executed by the Parish President. It has to be filed in the Court House to complete it. Michelle will file it by tomorrow (Fri. March 23, 2018). Derek Martin (MPH) has already prepared the plat to be filed with this order.
- A courtesy letter will be sent early next week to the landowners signed jointly by the Parish President and me on Parish letterhead. Ms. Neil has a draft of the letter and Derek needs to provide a list of the names and addresses of the landowners to send this letter. Michelle will add to the letter that the Corps is predicting a second high water event later this spring, thus making this work an urgent situation.
- As per the CEA between TPCG and TLCD in 2016, TLCD will be paying for the material (dirt) and labor for the
  repairs/rehabilitation of the levees along the MTG alignment and TPCG will pay for the Geraldine Road work.
  Mitch Marmande is working on amending the 2016 CEA to account for this current effort as well as the duties
  and responsibilities for the "After the Fact Permitting". Being the 2016 levee work overlays on the 2011 work
  done by TPCG and this new 2018 work also falls under the same alignment, we will re-apply this as one permit.
  GIS is handling this effort for TLCD.
- TLCD has already approved a Change Order on an indefinite delivery contract with Low Land Construction to
  provide up to 60K Cubic Yards of material (truck measure) in the Bayou Black area for a price of \$7.50 CY (Total
  Change Order is \$450K). Ben Elliot will transmit this change order to Low Land by tomorrow (Fri March 23,
  2018) and issue a "Notice to Proceed".
- TPCG (Angela Guidry) has taken quotes to provide the labor for this work. The payment will be based upon the amount of material that TLCD buys from Low Land. The low responsive contractor was Norris & Boudreaux at a price of \$4.50 CY plus mob and de-grassing. The total price for the labor is \$368.500.00. Last night (Wed March 21. 2018), the TLCD Board approved using this quote and to reimburse TPCG for the labor for work along the MTG alignment. If any of this material and labor is needed for the Geraldine Road area, TPCG will reimburse TLCD. We expect over 90% of the work to be done along the MTG alignment. Angela Guidry will issue the "Notice to Proceed" for the labor by tomorrow (Friday).
- TLCD will cover the cost of the inspections and consultants for this effort.
- Joe Chauvin has met with Gulf South Pipeline on this work. TLCD will have to execute an "Encroachment Agreement". I want Mitch to review this agreement before I execute it.
- Yesterday, Mr. Benny Cenac gave TLCD a temp. servitude to allow us to stock pile dirt on his property at the end of Gator Court for this project. Jacob will be filing this agreement in the Court House today.

I know this is a lot of information with a lot of moving parts and multiple partners. Thus, please let us know if I left something out of if anyone has any concerns. Let the work begin!
