Dear Mr. Allen Theriot:

As per your request, please accept this letter as our revised proposal for the above referenced project. Dupre Brothers Construction Co. shall provide the necessary labor and equipment to change out 12"x12" creosote timbers, 8"x8" creosote timber supports, I-beams and center pin pivot jack as directed by TPCG. Our estimate is based on the following scope of work:

Scope of Work

- 1) Mobilize Crew and tools to Smith Ridge Bridge.
- 2) TPCG will close bridge to vehicular and marine traffic during construction activities. Bridge will be lifted in the open position for marine traffic.
- 3) Crew shall install temporary timber piles and beams to jack up bridge to raise bridge off of super structure foundation. All timber piles driven shall remain in place for future use.
- 4) Crew shall remove center pin (pivot jack), track guide with rollers, 8"x8" timbers, 12"x12" timbers and I-beams under super structure.
- 5) Crew shall install four (4) new 12"x12" creosote timbers anchored with ¾" drift pins.
- 6) Crew shall install fourteen (14) new 8"x8" creosote timbers and two (2) W8x15 galvanized I-beams anchored with ¾" drift pins and lag bolts.
- 7) Crew shall install track guide with rollers fasten to bridge structure.
- 8) Crew shall install ¾" base plate and weld to beams then install center pin (pivot jack) and weld to base plate.
- 9) Crew shall adjust nuts, and threaded shaft on pivot jack as directed by TPCG.
- 10) TPCG shall notify residents of expected limitations and/or closures to vehicle traffic.
- 11) TPCG shall notify USCG of expected limitations and/or closures to marine traffic.



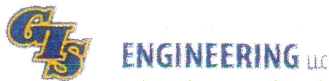



Please accept this correspondence as our formal request for a contract amendment for the above referenced project. All South requests an amendment to accommodate cost for additional topographic surveying and production and analysis of a hydraulic model for the project area.

Note that our original engineering agreement provides for a limited topographic survey, development and analysis of a hydraulic model and preparation of upgrade cost estimates and alternatives and preparation of a written report. As you are aware the limited topographic survey and available information was not sufficient to produce the hydraulic model or provide upgrade recommendations or cost estimates. At this point All South has billed the Parish a total of \$4,182.75 of the original \$24,100.00 budget allocated for the project which equates to the amount of \$19,917.25 of allocated budget remaining.

We estimate the cost of the additional required topographic survey to be \$18,900.00 (see man-hour breakdown below) while the cost of creating and analyzing a hydraulic model, preparing recommended upgrades and cost estimates and preparation of the Report to be \$21,750.00 (see man-hour breakdown below) which equates to a total \$40,650.00. Since we still have \$19,917.25 remaining in our original budget then the additional amount required to perform the above services is $\$40,650.00 - \$19,917.25 = \$20,732.75$. We therefore respectfully request an amendment to our engineering agreement increasing the allocated budget of the Study & Report phase by \$20,732.75. In addition, we propose to perform and invoice all work described above on a time & material basis.

Man-hour breakdown:

Survey: 242 structures. A 2-man survey crew can realistically and steadily take grate/top and invert elevation shots and note pipe sizes & materials at the rate of about 3 structures per hour (includes removing & reinstalling grates/lids with help from others). Number hours required = $242 \text{ structures} \div 3 \text{ structures/hour} = 80 \text{ hours}$. Now add 10 hours contingency = 90 hours x \$210.00/hour (2-man survey crew) = \$18,900.00.

Hydraulic Model, Analysis, Estimates & Report: This effort was derived by reviewing the number of hours required to create and analyze the hydraulic model for the sports park (100 hours) then added 50 hours to account for an increase in level of complexity (over 200 pipes & 200 structures), for making recommendations, estimates and report = 150 hours x \$145.00/Hour (professional engineer level III) = \$21,750.00.

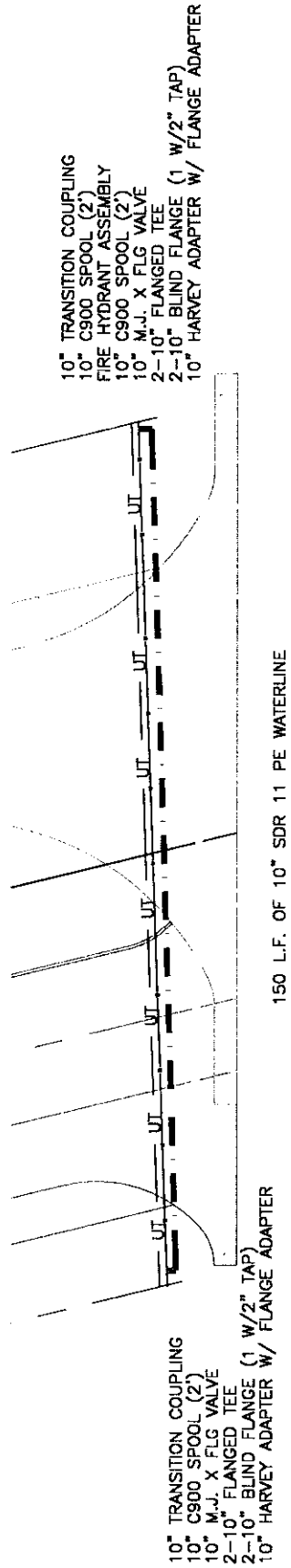
