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CONTRACT

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into as of this _____ day of ______, 2017 ("Effective Date"), between Three Ridge Farms, LLC (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Three Ridge") and Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "TPCG"). Subject to all of the terms and conditions hereof, Three Ridge shall render mitigation banking services to TPCG as set forth in this Agreement. The Specifications, Exhibit "A", are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. The Upper Bayou Folse Mitigation Bank is an approved mitigation bank in accordance with federal and state guidelines. The project defined in this Agreement is not a continuation of any agreement, contract or services rendered by TPCG on behalf of Three Ridge. The project location is the Upper Bayou Folse Mitigation Bank in Lafourche Parish, Louisiana as described on Exhibit "B", attached hereto and made a part hereof.

The stated addresses of the parties shall be used for any notices to be provided under this agreement until one party provides the other party with written notice of a change of address.

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the covenants and conditions herein contained, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged by and between the parties hereto, Three Ridge and TPCG agree as follows:

1. PAYMENTS

Three Ridge will be compensated by TPCG for the services to be performed in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Agreement as follows:

- A. For the wetland mitigation services provided in the Specifications, TPCG shall pay Three Ridge for Three-tenths (0.3) acre of bottomland hardwood mitigation located within the Upper Bayou Folse Mitigation Bank, the total nonrefundable sum of Eighteen Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$18,000.00).
- B. Concurrently with the signature of this Agreement by TPCG, TPCG shall pay to Three Ridge the nonrefundable payment specified in Paragraph 1.A. by wire transfer, certified check or other secured funds. The payment of the funds

specified in Paragraph 1.A. shall be TPCG's only obligation under this Agreement.

2. THREE RIDGE'S SERVICES

Three Ridge owns and operates the Upper Bayou Folse Mitigation Bank and is prepared to and upon receipt of the payment specified in Paragraph 1.A. shall immediately commence to render all services and shall satisfy all of the terms and conditions specified in the Specifications. Three Ridge's obligations under this Agreement shall be performed within the time set forth in the Specifications or the time constraints contained within the Louisiana Department of Natural Resources Coastal Use Permit No. P20160299 and U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Permit No. MVN-2016-00503-WH.

3. WARRANTEE

Three Ridge does hereby warrant that it has record title to the Upper Bayou Folse Mitigation Bank and that it has all rights to perform the obligations undertaken by Three Ridge in this Agreement. The parties hereto warrant to each other that they have the right to enter into this Agreement.

4. GOVERNMENTAL COMPLIANCE AND NOTICES

In performing its obligations under this Agreement, Three Ridge agrees to comply with all laws and regulations of any federal, state or local governmental authority having jurisdiction. Three Ridge shall timely file all necessary reports required by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

5. JURISDICTION

This Agreement shall be governed and construed for all purposes under and in accordance with laws of the State of Louisiana.

6. MUTUAL NEGOTIATIONS

This Agreement was confected by mutual negotiations between Three Ridge and TPCG and any ambiguity which may be contained herein shall not be construed in favor of one party or against another.

7. SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS

This Agreement shall be binding on the parties hereto, and their successors, assigns, lessees and sublessees.

8. <u>SAVINGS AND SEVERABILITY</u>

If any portion of this Agreement or if the application of this Agreement to any person or circumstance shall to any extent be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then the remainder of this Agreement and the application of such provisions to persons or circumstances other than those held to be invalid shall not be affected thereby. Moreover, each provision of this Agreement shall be valid and enforced to the fullest extent permitted by applicable law.

SPECIFICATIONS

Three Ridge Farms, LLC (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Three Ridge"), the operator of the Upper Bayou Folse Mitigation Bank located in Lafourche Parish, Louisiana, on behalf of Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government, shall perform the following wetland mitigation in fulfillment of the Louisiana Department of Natural Resources Coastal Use Permit No. P20160299 and U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Permit No. MVN-2016-00503-WH, attached hereto as Exhibit "C" and made a part hereof, and shall restore Three-tenths (0.3) acre of a former bottomland hardwood forest as follows:

- 1. Planting will be conducted during the non-growing season which is defined as December 15th through March 15th.
- 2. Forested wetland rehabilitation will be conducted in accordance with the approved Mitigation Banking Instrument.
- 3. If any portion of the site is destroyed or adversely impacted by activities and/or occurrences, other than by Acts of God, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers shall be so advised in writing by Three Ridge and restoration shall be made by Three Ridge to the affected area or equal mitigation shall be implemented by Three Ridge, all as approved by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the Louisiana Department of Natural Resources.
- 4. Three Ridge has or shall immediately record a conservation servitude to ensure that, in the event that the property is sold, the new owner of the mitigation area will be aware of limitations pertaining to activities within the mitigation site. The conservation servitude will be filed in the conveyance records of Lafourche Parish, Louisiana.

SECTION I

BE IT ORDAINED that the Terrebonne Parish Council, in regular session convened, acting pursuant to the Home Rule Charter for a Consolidated Government, does hereby revoke the dedication of Right-of-Way for approximately 450 linear feet of Safety Road as more fully shown on the plat entitled "Proposed Public Right-of-Way Revocation Along Safety Road", and attached as Exhibit "A".

SECTION II

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this revocation is conditioned upon this section of road in question does not serve a public purpose and does not further the interests of the Parish and Parish Road System.

SECTION III

If any word, clause, phrase, section or other portion of this ordinance shall be declared null, void, invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional, the remaining words, clauses, phrases, sections and other portions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect, the provisions of this ordinance hereby being declared to be severable.
