WHEREAS: respectful and inclusive language is essential to the movement for the dignity and humanity of people with intellectual disabilities. However, much of society does not recognize the hurtful, dehumanizing and exclusive effects of the words "retard" and "retarded": and

WHEREAS: it is time to address the slur "retard(ed)" and raise the consciousness of society to its hurtful effects: and

WHEREAS: the Art of Respect Program is an ongoing effort by Special Olympics, Best Buddies International and their supporters South Central Louisiana Human Services Authority, Bayouland Families Helping Families, Terrebonne ARC, Assumption ARC, St. Charles ARC, St. Mary ARC (The Center), Lafourche ARC, Special Education District #1 (The Center), St. John ARC and St. James ARC to raise the consciousness of society about the dehumanizing and hurtful effects of the word "retard(ed)" and encourage people to pledge to stop using the R-word: and

Late goal lifts Lady Terriers to fourth state title

NEW ORLEANS -- It may not have been an actual golden goal, but it sure was close.

With the Louisiana High School Athletic Association Division III girls soccer championship match tied late in overtime and nudging further and further toward sudden-death overtime and potentially a penalty-kick shootout on Wednesday night, Vandebilt Catholic senior Grace Champagne worked her magic.

Champagne just spent nearly the last hour of play sending a barrage of shots in the direction of Loyola College Prep goalie Mary Kathryn Smith, but had no goal to show for it.

But 7 minutes into the second half of a 20-minute overtime period, Champagne juked a defender by quickly pulling the ball back and angling a shot in the upper left-hand corner just over the outstretched arm of Smith for a dramatic goal.

Three minutes later, when the final whistle blew, the No. 1 Lady Terriers snatched a 2-1 victory and took home their second straight Division III state title and fourth in Vandebilt girls soccer history.

If the match would have gone three more minutes without a goal, the teams would have had to play two five-minute golden goal (sudden death) halves with the first team to score winning. If no goals were scored, the winner would have been settled by penalty kicks.

But instead, Vandebilt players get their fourth golden star on their jerseys, one for each state title in program history, and the eight Lady Terriers seniors (Champagne, Gabrielle Bergeron, Elena Callejas, Hannah Cuneo, Julianne DeBlieux, Emma Guidry, Madeline Haydel and Julia Wood) left Tad Gormley Stadium as back-to-back champions thanks to Champagne's goal.

"I kept getting behind their line so I knew I was going to get one eventually," said Champagne, who was named the D-III title match's Most Outstanding Player for the second year in a row. "I just kept shooting, and we pushed through. I knew I had to score. I pulled it back on her, got behind her and shot and got it in the upper 90. It's awesome to go out my senior year with two straight state championships."

Lady Terriers coach Phil Amedee said he was glad Champagne ended things when she did.

"You start thinking golden goal and PKs," Amedee said. "You never want to have the game in PKs. Grace made that great individual effort and pulled us out of it."

Vandebilt, which was making its 10th state title match appearance and also won state titles in 2008 and 2009, ends its season at 25-4-3 overall, and No. 2 Loyola of Shreveport finishes at 21-7-3 overall.

The Lady Terriers struck in the first minute when Molly Thompson looped in a goal from 25 yards out that went over the head of Smith for the 1-0 Vandebilt advantage.

"They were pushing their defense to the back," Thompson said. "It gave us enough space to take some shots from far out."

Guidry, the Lady Terriers goalie, then recorded a couple of stellar saves to keep Loyola off the scoreboard before Thompson had a shot go wide at the midway point of the first half.

Vandebilt then had two more chances on goal that failed before Guidry again came up big making a save in a one-on-situation with Loyola's Rebecca Mays.

In the 33rd minutes, Loyola equalized when Shannon Anderson delivered a perfect free kick from 27 yards out that she dropped over the outreached arm of Guidry and under the crossbar for the 1-1 tie.

"It was a fantastic free kick," Loyola coach Mark Matlock said. "Shannon is very consistent with her free kicks, just a lot of power and pace right under the bar. It was a great goal to get us back in the game."

The Lady Terriers could not connect on a couple late chances before the game went to halftime tied at 1.

Vandebilt had numerous shots on goal in the second half, but could not connect and had a couple more chances in the first half of the overtime period before Champagne found the back of the net with 3 minutes left in the second half of overtime.

"We controlled the flow in the second half, but that doesn't matter because we didn't put one in," Amedee said. "We had confidence that sooner or later we would get one to sneak in there and we did."

Amedee said after defeating Loyola 2-0 earlier in the season, the Flyers came ready to play in Wednesday night.

"They are well-coached and dangerous," Amedee said. "He came out with a great game plan to stop our speed and our counter attack. But we just kept plugging away. The girls remained confident and worked through it. Ultimately it was two great individual efforts (on the goals by Thompson and Champagne) that won the game for us."

Matlock said he could not have asked for anything more of his team.

"We left everything out there, and we could walk off the field with our heads held high. We fought until the end even after they scored late. It was just a fantastic goal in the end to win the game," Matlock said "I am proud of my seven seniors and the class of our players and parents. We applauded the winners, and we were proud of our effort and we hope to be back next year."

The Lady Terriers relied heavily on Guidry, a four-year starter in goal, in key times in the match and she came through with some clutch saves.

"Emma is incredible," Amedee said. "She does not get nearly enough credit. She keeps us in games and makes some great saves. She is a really underrated keeper."

But Guidry said she was relieved that Champagne's late goal kept her out of the goal for the


potential penalty kick shootout.

"I was so nervous," Guidry said. "Winning this took a lot of heart, and I am so glad that we won it again."

While not able to attend the match on Wednesday night, Lady Terriers player Alaina Maiorana has been a huge part of Vandebilt's success in recent seasons. The junior has been battling Hodgkin's Lymphoma since 2015 and the Lady Terriers have rallied around her, keeping her as included as possible and playing with the same unwavering spirit in which she has fought the disease.

She was on Face Time when her name was announced prior to the title match and never far from the players and coaches hearts and minds during and after it.

"I know she is going to be just excited as we are," said Wood, who is close with Maiorana. "I know she is proud of us, and we are proud of her for fighting even a bigger battle than we did."

Vandebilt pole vaulter defends state title

For the second straight year Vandebilt Catholic girls' pole vaulter Brooke Brunet took home a state championship at the AllState Sugar Bowl/Louisiana High School Athletic Association state indoor track and field meet in Baton Rouge on Feb. 18.

Brunet cleared 12-feet to win the Division I state indoor pole vaulting title, which was held at LSU's Carl Maddox Fieldhouse. She beat state runner-up Annemarie Broussard of Abbeville (11 feet, 3 inches) and third-place Kalee Jo Banks of Ursuline Academy (10-07).

Brunet had the highest jump out of all pole vaulters in both divisions at the state meet. She competed in Division I at the state indoor meet, which consists of schools in Classes 5A and 4A. Division II is made up of all smaller state classes.

At last year's indoor meet, she won her first ever state title with a mark of 12-3 1/4.

Brunet said it was an honor to win another indoor state championship

"It feels great. I was confident that I would do it again," Brunet said. "It was just like last year, so just to win it two years in a row is even better. It was great to win it in my senior year. It felt surreal that it was my last state indoor meet, so I just wanted to make the best of it."

Now Brunet is preparing for her senior year of outdoor track.

After winning two straight indoor state pole vault titles, she is focused on bringing home her first Class 4A state outdoor title in the pole vault in May. She has finished as a state outdoor runner-up in the event in recent years.

"After four years of getting second place, I want to get that top spot. That's my motivation," Brunet said. "I don't want to repeat the last four years. I really want that top spot that I have been dreaming for since eighth grade."

Longtime local pole vaulting coach Kevin Trosclair said Brunet has devoted a lot of time towards repeating her state indoor championship.

"It was really special," Trosclair said. "We didn't get the outdoor title last year. She won indoor last year, so to come back and do well at indoor this year is great. What's really promising is that she's moving up in poles. She did what she needed to do and jumped real well. She continues to grasp what she has to do, and she's maturing. In the future I think it's going to help her out."

Trosclair said he has high expectations for Brunet's final year of outdoor track, where he wants her to set a new personal record and win a state pole vaulting title.

"Hopefully we'll get an outdoor title. She's been in the hunt for the last four years and could never get quiet there," Trosclair said. "I think she has a great opportunity, but the competition will be tough. Hopefully she can make it work. I'm hoping she can break the 13-foot mark, which I think is achievable for her. It's possible, but we have a few things we need to work on. If she could get to mid 13s, I'll be really happy."

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PARISH CODE OF TERREBONNE PARISH, CHAPTER 18, ARTICLE V. STOPPING, STANDING, AND PARKING, DIVISION 1. Any vehicle traveling on School Street shall adhere to the provisions of this ordinance.

If any word, clause, phrase, section or other portion of this ordinance shall be declared null, void, invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional, the remaining words, clauses, phrases, sections or other portions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect, the provisions of this section hereby being declared to be severable.

- **Sec. 6-175. - Setback requirements for construction of communication towers.**

- (a) Any freestanding tower constructed for communications or cellular phone purposes shall have setback requirements a distance equal to or greater than its height from any residential structure.
- (b) Homeowners permitting construction of a tower on home sites on which they reside shall be exempt from the setback requirements.
- (c) When constructing a tower in a residential area, public hearings will be encouraged to receive input from the residents.
- (d) Any guyed tower constructed for communications or cellular phone purposes shall have setback requirements within the guys from any residential structure.

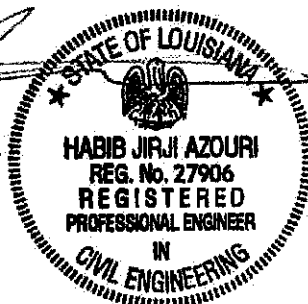
It is our understanding that the design of the referenced tower requires consideration of a contained fall radius in the event that a catastrophic wind speed would result in collapse. Although the tower is not designed to fail, stronger sections than required by analysis is provided in the lower sections of the tower. This will result in an increased safety factor in the lower sections. This design enables the tower to fail through a combination of bending and buckling in the upper portion of the tower under a catastrophic wind loading. Failure in this manner will result in the upper portion of the tower folding over the lower portion, resulting in a fall radius no greater than 50ft.

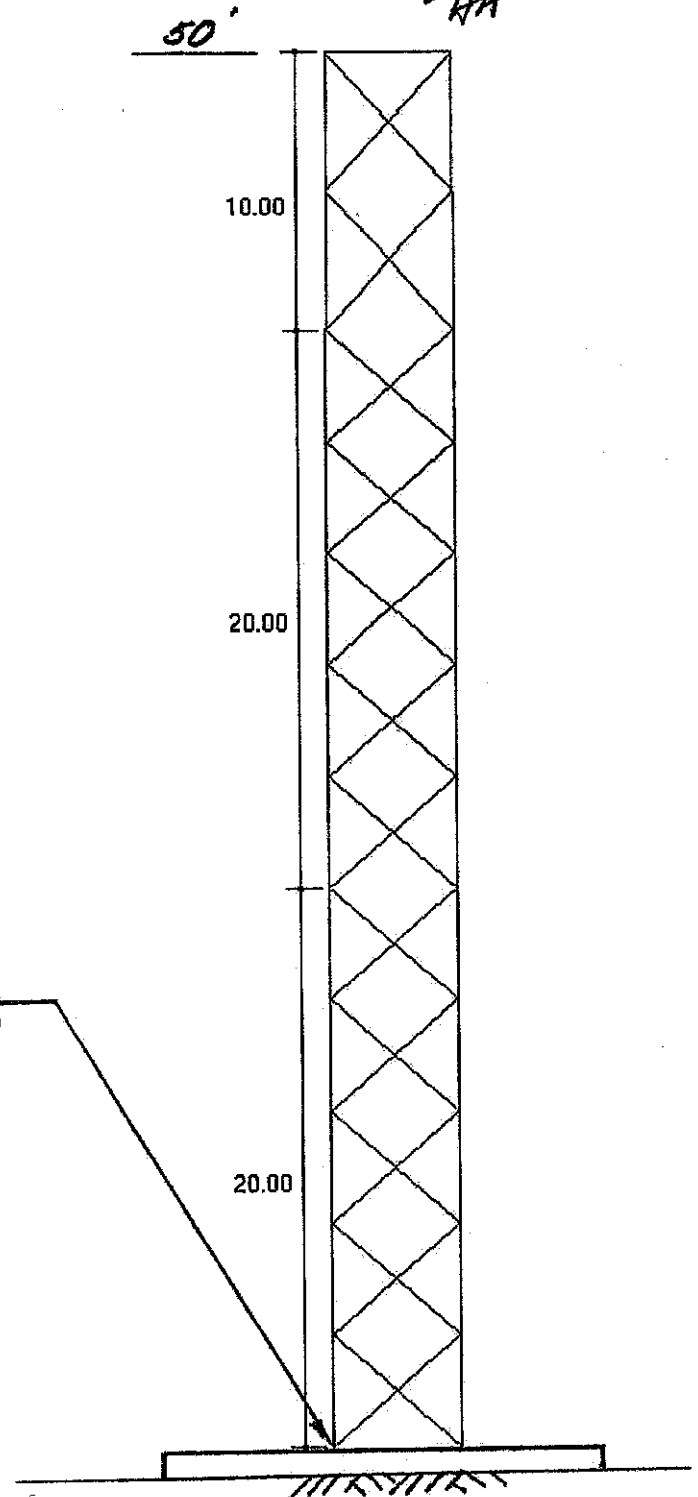

The proposed telecommunications tower to be located at 6282 West Main St., Houma, LA, is not our FCC Station Licensed "Broadcasting Transmitter Tower". Our actual FCC licensed "Radio Broadcast Transmitters and Towers" are located well outside the City of Houma and are much taller Located at:

(A)WGUO 29-43-49 N, 90-43-37 W- Burma Road, 7 miles NNE of Houma

(B) KDLC 29-20-48 N, 90-49-49 W- Bayou Delarge, 19 Miles South of Houma.

The purpose of the "Telecommunications Tower" is to receive Data for Emergency Alerts System, as well as to deliver data, audio to our real Radio "Broadcast Transmitter Towers" as described above for commercial purposes. The way we deliver data and audio to our actual "Broadcast Transmitter Tower" is through auxiliary microwave point to point dishes and systems in the 940 Mhz to 950 Mhz licensed band. The data will use the unlicensed wireless 5.8 Ghz band. These systems use small parabolic dishes aimed to a dish at the actual "Radio Broadcast Transmitter Tower" and emit extremely low RF not to be received by the public.

Our actual FCC Licensed "Radio Broadcasting Transmitter Tower" is much taller in height, emits high radio frequency power, location and power are dictated by FCC. Our FCC Licensed "Radio Broadcast Transmitters"...



- (a) Any freestanding tower constructed for communications or cellular phone purposes shall have setback requirements a distance equal to or greater than its height from any residential structure.
- (b) Homeowners permitting construction of a tower on home sites on which they reside shall be exempt from the setback requirements.
- (c) When constructing a tower in a residential area, public hearings will be encouraged to receive input from the residents.
- (d) Any guyed tower constructed for communications or cellular phone purposes shall have setback requirements within the guys from any residential structure.
