APPROVAL REQUESTED: Rezone from R-3 to C-1 **RECOMMENDATION:** APPROVAL

PROPOSAL:

The applicant is requesting to rezone from R-3 (Multi-Family Residential) to C-1 (Central Business) to allow for an office building.

ANALYSIS:

The proposed development is exempt from the minimum size requirement for new districts since the property currently abuts an existing C-1 district.

The Zoning Ordinance states that in order to rezone property, one of the following conditions must apply:

1. Error
2. Change in conditions
3. Increase in need for sites for business or industry
4. Subdivision of land

Staff feels that the application fits under items 2 and 3. The proposed office will allow for renovations to an existing vacant structure and bring it to code. It will help accommodate the existing business in the downtown area and have ~~no~~ impact on the surrounding residential neighborhood.

Adequate public notice was provided. A site visit was performed, and all adjacent property owners were notified. Staff received 2 calls regarding this request; one requesting more information and one indicating no objection to the rezone request.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends APPROVAL of the request.

We are requesting that the new bridge be named after Anthony "MUG" Cadere who died of cancer on February 9, 1999 and the opening of the new road falls on his Birthday March 27th

Mr. Cadere was born on Bayou Cane March 27 1939 in Terrebonne Parish. He left Houma Jr. High School in the eight grade to help raise his 3 siblings.

At the age of 19, he married Beverly Porche Cadere and was married for 40 years before his death. They raised 2 children Tonia Cadere Bergeron and Jenita Cadere Mai. They have 2 grandchildren Amanda Bergeron and Katie Mai Lewis. They also have 4 great grandchildren and 1 on the way. Julien Boudreaux VI, Lexi Grace Reavis, Zoey Elizabeth Lewis, Jax Anthony Lewis and baby Brunet.

Mr. Cadere was a butcher at the age of 18 for Conrad Robichaux and later went on to work for Thompson Meat Packing Co. in Thibodaux. In 1962 Mr. Cadere and his wife moved from Bayou Cane to Bayou Blue and built them a new house there to raise there family on 2 acres of property. Later on he decided to work in Construction, driving pilings out of New Orleans and joined the Carpenters Union for many years. After working for AF Blair for 10 years the recession struck our area and he was layed off. He decided along with his wife Beverly that they would open there own Commercial Construction Business in 1981 during the recession with only \$200.00. As a contractor he did a lot of work for the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government, renovated the old jail house and was in the process of building the Morgue and a large storage building for the Terrebonne Parish Civic Center in Houma when he fell sick with Lung cancer. His company did a lot of work for the Archdiocese in Terrebonne and Lafourch Parishes. He constructed a lot of buildings for Caro Produce at the time. He did work for the boat company Conrad Industries in Morgan City. McDermott, he renovated a 3 story barge for the US Goverment for Marine Life.

Mr. Cadere was also part owner and builder of Bayou Gardens Mini Storages by the mall.

In spite of Mr. Cadere running a very successful Commercial Construction Business, he found time to serve his Community.

Mr. Cadere was the fair chairman for St. Louis Church Food and Fun Festival for over 10 years. Him and his crew constructed and built the stands for the fair at his expense, he would also find the alligator

meat and catch the shrimp for the fair suppers.

Mr Cadiere also built a beautiful ball park behind the Mausoleum of St. Louis Church for the people of Bayou Blue to enjoy, again with his own equipment and time. He also supervised the construction of the St. Jude Shrine in the 80's with the KC and other parishioners of St. Louis Church. He was also a 3rd degree for the Knights of Columbus.

Mr. Cadiere was the first man in St. Louis Parish Church to receive a medal from the Pope for his services to the community. Presented by Bishop Boudreaux at St Francis Church.

Mr. Cadiere was also an avid hunter, he was the treasurer for the Bayou Blue Buck Club for 20 years. He often paid the dues for the younger hunters to be able to hunt when they couldn't afford it.

Mr. Cadiere was also an avid fisherman/ shrimper and built 2 camps. One on Lake Decade and one on the Rock a Sea. He also help construct other camps in the area driving pilens and never charging a dime.

Mr. Cadiere was also a softball coach for the Bayou Blue Drifters Womens softball team. When his grand daughter Katie Mai became a softball player for TPR, he was not only her number one fan, but he would cook for the softball tournaments to raise money for there team to travel for allstars.

Mr. Cadiere loved Mardi Gras, before the buses became popular, he built a trailer for his Daughter Jenita and the riders to ride around on the day of there parade and cooked them fried food for lunch time for her whole float to enjoy.

Mr Anthony was not only a self made business man, but he was great husband, father and grandfather to his family. He was a builder of his community and surrounding areas. He brought people together and never met a stranger. He donated his time and services and never asked for a dime or recoginiton.

Today I think its time for him to be recognized, so we are asking in consideration for the new bridge for the Bayou Gardens extension crossing the St. Louis Canal to be named after him.


