AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2017 ADOPTED OPERATING BUDGET AND 5-YEAR CAPITAL OUTLAY OF THE TERREBONNE PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT FOR THE FOLLOWING ITEMS AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS.

- I. Parish Sports Park Complex, \$200,000
- II. Upper Little Caillou Pump Station, \$399,905

SECTION I

WHEREAS, additional funding is needed for the construction of a parking lot for the Parish Sports Park Complex, and

WHEREAS, \$250,000 of funding is available in the Capital budget, and

WHEREAS, the \$200,000 additional funding needed will come from Terrebonne Parish Recreation District No. 2/3, and

WHEREAS, Parish President Gordon E. Dove has recommended that the firm of All South Consulting Engineers, LLC, be retained to provide the necessary services for this project.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Terrebonne Parish Council, on behalf of the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government, that the 2017 Adopted Operating Budget and 5-Year Capital Outlay of the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government be amended for the Bayou Sports Park. (Attachment A)

NOW, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the appointment by Parish President Gordon E. Dove be ratified and that the engineering firm of All South Consulting Engineers, LLC be retained to provide the necessary professional services for the construction of the parking lot at the Bayou Sports Park and that Parish President Gordon E. Dove be authorized to execute any and all documents with said firm for this project.

SECTION II

WHEREAS, funding is needed for the Upper Little Caillou Pump Station, and

WHEREAS, the funding source is from the Drainage Department for \$399,905.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the Terrebonne Parish Council, on behalf of the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government, that the 2017 Adopted Operating Budget and 5-Year Capital Outlay Budget be amended to recognize the funding of the Upper Little Caillou Pump Station. (Attachment B)

Dear Commissioners,

I am writing to you today regarding the status of development of the Sports Complex. As you know the Parish, the State Legislature, CVB along with Recreation District 2-3 have invested significant amounts of public funds toward the development of a functional sports complex to provide enhanced recreation opportunities for Terrebonne residents and visitors to our community.


It is unfortunate, but due to the economic downturn, the State's financial commitment to the project, at least in the short term, is questionable. Based on HIB 2, as approved by the Legislature and awaiting the Governor's signature, an allocation of \$1,984,000 has been placed in Priority 5, which may result in additional State funding being available in July 2018, at the earliest.

Given these circumstances, it is imperative that we work together to find a common solution to make the Park functional for the residents of Terrebonne, in the near term. With that thought in mind, it is my understanding that the Houma-Terrebonne Soccer Association is willing to contribute \$150,000 of in-kind services toward the further development of the soccer fields, at no cost to the public, if we assist in providing a parking area sufficient to park 300 vehicles, to be located in an area to equally serve the patrons of the baseball facilities. Initial estimates indicate that the parking area will cost approximately \$400,000. I am requesting that the district contribute \$200,000 to this project, with the Parish providing the remainder of the funds, and managing the construction of the much needed parking area.

Upon approval of your Board, I will immediately initiate the engineering and construction phase, hopefully to be complete before year's end.

Thank you very much for your consideration and leadership in this significant recreation and economic development project for this region of the State.

SECTION I

WHEREAS, the Houma Navigation Canal is critical to the success of the Port of Terrebonne, and the economy of southern LA and needs to be dredged to its authorized depth of 15 feet, and

WHEREAS, the dredging project will benefit the local economy by providing for increased shipyard, and fabrication opportunities, with the increased depth of the canal, and

WHEREAS, the Terrebonne Port Commission will enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for one year period and provide funding assistance related to the costs of the maintenance dredging of the Houma Navigation Canal, and

WHEREAS, the dredging of the Houma Navigation Canal will add some economic value to the Parish by allowing for the continuation of shipyard and fabrication opportunities as well as promoting and developing new opportunities in the local economy, and

WHEREAS, the Parish will transfer \$1,500,000 to the Terrebonne Port Commission, a non-federal contribution, to Dredging of the Lower Reaches of the Houma Navigation Canal scheduled for 2017, and

WHEREAS, the funding for this transfer is coming from the General Fund Economic Development restricted fund balance, general fund transfers in Road and Bridge Fund and General Fund Fund Balance.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Terrebonne Parish Council on behalf of the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government, that the 2017 Adopted Operating Budget be amended for the transfer to the Terrebonne Port Commission (Attachment A)

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, BY THE Terrebonne Parish Council, that Parish President, Gordon E. Dove, is authorized to enter into an Cooperative Endeavor Agreement with the Terrebonne Port Commission, subject to approval by legal counsel for the Parish.

**COOPERATIVE ENDEAVOR AGREEMENT
BY AND BETWEEN
TERREBONNE PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT
AND
TERREBONNE PORT COMMISSION**

This agreement is entered into on the dates set forth herein by and between:

I. THE PARTIES

1.1. **TERREBONNE PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT**, a political subdivision of the State of Louisiana, herein represented by Gordon E. Dove, President of Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government, by virtue of Terrebonne Parish Council Ordinance No. _____ (“TPCG”); and,

1.2. **TERREBONNE PORT COMMISSION**, a political subdivision of the State of Louisiana, herein represented by its duly authorized Executive Director, David Rabalais, by virtue of the attached Resolution, (“TPC”);

II. PREAMBLES

2.1. WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 14(C) of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana provides that "For a public purpose, the state and its political subdivisions ... may engage in cooperative endeavors with each other, with the United States or its agencies, or with any public or private association, corporation, or individual;" and;

2.2. WHEREAS, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) has federal authorization to maintain the Houma Navigation Canal (HNC) at a depth of 15 feet; and

2.3. WHEREAS, USACE has received approval of \$800,000.00 in federal funds for use in dredging the HNC, and it plans to dredge the HNC to a depth of 13 feet, beginning in 2017; and

2.4. WHEREAS, additional funds are needed, but have not been federally granted, in order to dredge the HNC to the maximum authorized depth; and

2.5. WHEREAS, TPC issued a letter of intent to the Army Corps of Engineers, pledging the contribution of TPC funds for assistance related to the costs of the maintenance dredging of the HNC to its federally authorized maximum depth;

2.6. WHEREAS, TPC has requested TPCG to contribute funds for those purposes; and

2.7. WHEREAS, the maintenance of the HNC is critical to the success of both TPC and the economy of TPCG; and

2.8. WHEREAS, TPCG is authorized to provide for economic and industrial development within its jurisdiction and desires to contribute funds for the above stated purposes; and

2.9. WHEREAS, TPCG and TPC further desire that a cooperative endeavor agreement be formed by and between themselves relative to this one time funding of USACE’s congressional mandate to maintain the federally authorized depth of the HNC as a demonstration of their common interest in the accomplishment of said project; and,

2.10. WHEREAS, TPCG further believes that entering into this Agreement with TPC to provide partial funding of the USACE’s federally mandated obligation to maintain the depth of the HNC, and the expenditure or transfer of public funds according to the terms of this cooperative endeavor,

taken as a whole, is not gratuitous, and that TPCG has a demonstrable, objective, and reasonable expectation of receiving at least equivalent value, including, but not limited to additional tax dollars through increased jobs and/or preventing the loss of tax dollars by decreases in employment, in exchange for the expenditure or transfer of its public funds; and

2.11. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AGREED by and between the aforementioned parties that:

III. PURPOSE

3.1. The purpose of this cooperative endeavor agreement is to memorialize TPCG's contribution towards the USACE's congressional maintenance dredging mandate to TPC for the benefit of USACE, in accordance with the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to be executed by and between the USACE and the TPC, for use in the dredging of the HNC by the USACE (the "Project"), and to provide for matters relative thereto. By providing for the contribution of funds to the USACE's maintenance dredging of the HNC, the parties intend to benefit the local economy by facilitating economic and industrial development and stability within the Parish.

IV. TERM

4.1. It is agreed by and between the parties that this Agreement is for a one-time funding by TPCG to TPC for the purposes described in this Agreement. The term of this Agreement shall commence on the date of execution of this Agreement by both parties, and all applicable obligations and conditions shall remain effective as applicable to ensure an accounting for the use of the public funds herein in accordance with this Agreement.

V. DELIVERABLES

5.1. TPCG shall remit to TPC in August 2017, a one-time payment in the total amount of One Million Five Hundred Thousand and no/100 (\$1,500,000.00) Dollars ("Funds"), as set out in and subject to the approved budget of the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government.

5.2. These Funds shall be for the benefit of USACE, who shall be a third-party beneficiary of this Agreement, and said Funds shall be used for the sole purpose of partially funding the USACE's federal mandate to maintenance dredge the HNC (the "Project"), as more fully described in the TPC Letter of Intent to the USACE dated August 1, 2017 (Attachment A).

5.3. TPC shall hold these funds until such time that it is required to release and remit them to the USACE.

VI. CONSIDERATION

6.1. In consideration of the Funds contributed herein, when and as required by the USACE, and in accordance with any Memorandum of Agreement between the USACE and TPC, TPC shall in a timely fashion release and remit the Funds to the USACE.

6.2. In the event all or any portion of the Funds are not expended for the EXPRESSED purpose of the Project by the end the contract term, TPC shall immediately reimburse TPCG the full amount of unused funds.

6.3. Within 15 days of any payment of Funds to the USACE, whether made in full or in part, TPC shall present documentation, in a form satisfactory to TPCG's CFO, to include copies of payments and receipts, that funds were expended in strict accordance with expressed purpose of this Agreement.

6.4. TPC shall monitor the Project and use of funds by USACE, and TPC shall immediately notify TPCG of any matters arising during the effective dates of this Agreement which may affect TPCG or alter the scope of the Project.

6.5. TPC shall make every reasonable effort to obtain copies of all Project documents from USACE, and TPC shall provide to TPCG, within 15 days of TPC's receipt of same, copies of the Project documents. TPC shall also provide TPCG, within 15 days of TPC's receipt, a copy of the

fully executed Memorandum of Agreement between the Corps and TPC, including any items annexed thereto or referred to therein.

6.6. No costs or expenses incurred by either party in performance of this Agreement shall be reimbursed or paid by the other party unless agreed upon in writing by the parties.

6.7. TPCG and TPC agree TPCG shall not be obligated to pay any additional funds and TPCG's agreement to pay is capped at \$1,500,000.00.

VII. ENTIRE AGREEMENT; MODIFICATION

7.1. All four corners of this Agreement, including the Preambles, and including any attachments that are expressly referred to in this Agreement, embody the complete agreement of the parties, superseding all oral or written previous or contemporary agreements between the parties relating to matters in this Agreement. No representations were made or relied upon by either party, other than those that are expressly set forth.

7.2. This Agreement may be modified or amended at any time by mutual consent of the parties, provided that, before any modification or amendment shall be operative and valid, it shall be reduced to writing and signed by both parties.

VIII. INDEMNIFICATION

8.1. TPC agrees to defend, indemnify, save, and hold harmless TPCG, including all parish departments, agencies, councils, boards and commissions, their officers, agents, servants and employees, including volunteers, from and against any and all claims, lawsuits and demands for damages under any theory of liability as allowed by law, other than for the negligence due TPCG or one of its employees, officers and/or agents, whether contractual, tortious, or implied, arising from this agreement, whether for breach of contract, injury or death to any person, or for the damage, loss or destruction of any property, including loss of use, which may occur or in any way grow out of any breach, act or omission, whether intentional or unintentional, and any negligence, or strict liability of TPC, its subcontractors, agents, servants, officers and/or employees, related to the performance or nonperformance of the Agreement herein entered into, including and as a result of any such claims, lawsuits and demands, TPC agrees to investigate, handle, respond to, provide defense for and defend any such claims, demands or suits related thereto, at its sole expense, even if such claim, demand or suit is groundless, false or fraudulent. Damages are defined to include, but not be limited to, general, special, punitive, exemplary, delay, attorney fees, court costs, fines, penalties, interest, and/or expenses.

IX. TERMINATION

9.1. This Agreement shall be terminated under any or all of the following conditions:

9.1.1. By written mutual agreement and consent of the parties hereto.

9.1.2. By TPC or TPCG as a consequence of the failure of either party to comply with the terms and conditions of this Agreement in a satisfactory manner, proper allowance being made for circumstances beyond the control of either party

9.1.3. By thirty (30) days written notice by TPC or TPCG.

9.2. Upon termination under any provision, TPCG shall not be obligated to continue payments to TPC or its successors or assigns.

9.3. Upon termination of this agreement, TPC shall provide a final accounting of TPCG funds, and TPC shall return any unused Funds, whether in full or in part, to TPCG within 15 days of the date of termination.

X. NO WAIVER

The failure of TPCG or TPC to enforce any of the terms of this Agreement or to provide any of the supporting documentation in any particular instance shall not constitute a waiver of, or preclude the subsequent enforcement of, any or all of the terms or conditions of this Agreement.

XI. NON-APPROPRIATION

Notwithstanding any provisions herein, in the event sufficient funds for the performance of this contract are not appropriated by the governing authority of TPCG in any fiscal year covered by this contract, this Agreement may be terminated by TPCG giving notice to TPC of such facts and the Parish's intention to terminate its financial obligation.

XII. COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS

The parties hereto and their employees, contractors and agents shall comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, regulations and ordinances in carrying out the provisions of this Agreement.

XIII. CHOICE OF LAW

This Agreement shall be governed by Louisiana law and the provisions of this Agreement shall be enforced and brought in the Thirty-second Judicial District Court, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana.

XIV. LEGAL CONSTRUCTION

In case any one or more of the provisions contained in this Agreement shall for any reason be held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect, such invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability shall not affect any other provisions thereof and this Agreement shall be considered as if such invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision had never been contained in this Agreement.

XV. ASSIGNMENT

No assignment of this Contract or any right occurring under this shall be made in whole or in part by TPC; either voluntarily or involuntarily or by any process of law and shall not be or come under the control of creditors or trustee(s) of TPC, without the express prior written consent of TPCG. In the event of any assignment, the assignee shall assume the liability with TPC who shall continue to remain liable for the faithful performance of the Agreement.

XVI. AUDIT

16.1. It is hereby agreed that the Legislative Auditor of the State of Louisiana, and/or the Office of the Governor, Division of Administration auditors shall have the option of inspecting and auditing all data, records and accounts of TPC which relate to this Agreement, upon request.

16.2. It is further agreed that TPCG or its designated auditor shall have the option of inspecting and auditing all data, records and accounts of TPC which relate to this Agreement and the Memorandum of Agreement between TPC and USACE, and that a representative of TPC shall be available for assistance in reviewing such records and for answering questions relative to the same.

16.3. TPC and any contractors paid under this Agreement shall maintain all books and records pertaining to this Agreement for a period of five (5) years after the date of final payment or as required by applicable State and/or Federal law. Records shall be made available during normal working hours for this purpose.

XVII. SIGNATURES OF THE PARTIES

Terrebonne Port Commission (TPC), a political subdivision of the state of Louisiana and one of the local non-federal co-sponsors for the Houma Navigation Canal (HNC) Deepening Study, has a vested interest in assisting local industry's desire to have the HNC maintained to its federally authorized depth of (-15'). The HNC was completed in 1962 as a direct route to the US Gulf of Mexico and the rest of the world with project dimensions of 150 foot in width and a depth of (-15) feet. In 1973 authority was granted to increase the project dimensions from mile zero to the US Gulf of Mexico to a depth of (-18) feet and a width of 300 feet.

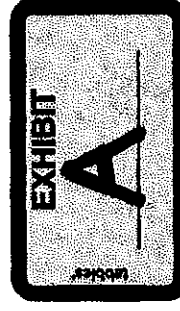
TPC understands that USACE plans to execute an HNC dredging contract for approximately \$800,000 to dredge approximately 100,000 cubic yards of material ASAP.

The intersection of Eldred Street and Guidry Street shall be declared as a “3 Way Stop” intersection, and appropriate “3 Way Stop” signs shall be erected and maintained along said roadways. Any vehicle traveling on Eldred Street and Guidry Street adhere to the provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION II

If any word, clause, phrase, section or other portion of this ordinance shall be declared null, void, invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional, the remaining words, clauses, phrases, sections or other portions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect, the provisions of this section hereby being declared to be severable.

SECTION III

Any ordinance or part thereof in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

SECTION IV

This ordinance shall become effective upon approval by the Parish President or as otherwise provided in Section 2-13 (b) of the Home Rule Charter for Consolidated Government for Terrebonne Parish, whichever occurs sooner.


