Sec. 5-58. - Bird sanctuary—Lafayette Woods Subdivision.

(a)

The entire area embraced within the boundary lines of Lafayette Woods Subdivision including Shady Lane Park is hereby designated as a bird sanctuary.

(b)

It shall be unlawful for any person to trap, hunt, shoot or attempt to shoot or molest in any manner any bird or wildfowl or to rob bird nests or wildfowl nests; provided, however, if starlings or similar birds are found to be congregating in such numbers in a particular locality that they constitute a nuisance or a menace to health or property in the opinion of the parish president and the parish council then such starlings or other birds which create a nuisance may be disposed of or destroyed.

(Ord. No. 4158, § 1(a), (b), 4-27-88)

Sec. 5-59. - Same—Parkway Circle Subdivision.

(a)

The entire area embraced within the boundary lines of Parkway Circle Subdivision is hereby designated as a bird sanctuary.

(b)

It shall be unlawful for any person to trap, hunt, or shoot or attempt to shoot or molest in any manner any bird or wildfowl or to rob bird nests or wildfowl nests; provided, however, if starlings or similar birds are

found to be congregating in such numbers in a particular locality that they constitute a nuisance or a menace to health or property in the opinion of the parish president and the parish council then such starlings or other birds which create a nuisance may be disposed of or destroyed.

#### • Sec. 5-60. - Same—City.

(a)

The entire area embraced within the corporate limits of the city is hereby designated as a bird sanctuary.

(b)

It shall be unlawful for any person to trap, hunt, shoot or attempt to shoot or molest in any manner any bird or wildfowl or to rob bird nests or wildfowl nests; provided, however, if starlings or similar birds are found to be congregating in such numbers in a particular locality that they constitute a nuisance or a menace to health or property in the opinion of the parish president and the parish council, then such starlings or other birds which create a nuisance may be disposed of or destroyed.

(City Code 1965, § 6-2)

#### • Sec. 5-61. - Same—Lisa Park Subdivision.

(a)

The entire area embraced within the boundary lines of Lisa Park Subdivision including Louis Drive is hereby designated as a bird sanctuary.

(b)

It shall be unlawful to trap, hunt, shoot or attempt to shoot or molest in any manner any bird or wildfowl or to rob bird nests or wildfowl nests; provided, however, if such starlings or similar birds are found to be congregating in such numbers in a particular locality that they constitute a nuisance or a menace to health or property, in the opinion of the parish president and the parish council, then such starlings or other birds which create a nuisance may be disposed of or destroyed.

(c)

The penalty for violating the provisions of this section shall be the same as contained in <u>section 5-33</u> of this Code.

(b)

It shall be unlawful to trap, hunt, shoot or attempt to shoot or molest in any manner any bird or wildfowl or to rob bird nests or wildfowl nests; provided, however, if such starlings or similar birds are found to be congregating in such numbers in a particular locality that they constitute a nuisance or a menace to health or property, in the opinion of the parish president and the parish council, then such starlings or other birds which create a nuisance may be disposed of or destroyed.

The penalty for violating the provisions of this section shall be the same as contained in section 5-33 of this Code.

ORDINANCE NO. 8024

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 5, "ANIMALS", ARTICLE III, "PROTECTED / ENDANGERED ANIMALS", TO ADD SECTION 5-62 "ALLEMAND SUBDIVISION", AS PER ATTACHMENT A, AND ADDRESS OTHER MATTERS RELATIVE THERETO.

#### SECTION I

BE IT ORDAINED by the Terrebonne Parish Council, in regular session convened, acting pursuant to the authority invested in it by the Constitution and laws of the State of Louisiana, the Home Rule Charter for a Consolidated Government for Terrebonne Parish, and including, but not limited to, LSA R.S. 33:1368 and other statutes of the State of Louisiana, to amend Chapter 5, "Animals", Article III, "Protected / Endangered Animals", to add Section 5-62 "Allemand Subdivision", as per Attachment A.

#### **SECTION II**

If any word, clause, phrase, section or other portion of this ordinance shall be declared null, void, invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional, the remaining words, clauses, phrases, sections and other portions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect, the provisions of this ordinance hereby being declared to be severable.

#### **SECTION III**

This ordinance shall become effective upon approval by the Parish President or as otherwise provided in Section 2-13 (b) of the Home Rule Charter for a Consolidated Government of Terrebonne Parish, whichever occurs sooner.

# ARTICLE III. - PROTECTED/ENDANGERED ANIMALS

## Sec. 5-62. - Same - Allemand Subdivision.

- (a) The entire area embraced within the boundary lines of Allemand Subdivision including Royce Street, Darlene Street, Doyle Street, Alcee Street and Oak Manor Court is hereby designated as a bird sanctuary.
- (b) It shall be unlawful to trap, hunt, shoot or attempt to shoot or molest in any manner any bird or wild fowl or to rob bird nests or wild fowl nests; provided, however, if such starlings or similar birds are found to be congregating in such numbers in a particular locality that they constitute a nuisance or a menace to health or property, in the opinion of the parish president and the parish council, then such starlings or other birds which create a nuisance may be disposed of or destroyed.
