Honorable Members of the Terrebonne Parish Council:

Tonight we are pleased to present the Terrebonne parish Veterans' Memorial District 2023 Operations and Maintenance Budget totaling \$496,865. On Wednesday, November 30, 2022, the Terrebonne Parish Council is scheduled to ratify the Budget plan that was adopted by the Veterans Board on November 17, 2022. The District will receive Ad Valorem taxes from the levy of their dedicated .5 mill property tax, approved by the voters on November 15, 2015.

The State of Louisiana created "The District" in the 2008 Regular Session, Act 231, under the provisions of LA R.S. 33:9357. Prior to the 2011 budget, the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government acted as the Fiscal Agent and included the District's limited financial activities within their budget. With the passage of the District's dedicated property tax and sale of the limited tax bonds, a separate accounting of the District's Financial Plan was presented beginning with Year 2011. The District shall have the powers and duties to operate, except that approval of the Terrebonne Parish Council shall first be obtained prior to any of the following actions by The District's board:

- 1. Adoption of an annual budget
- 2. Purchase, sale or encumbrance of immovable property.
- 3. Submitting for voter approval any tax proposal.
- 4. Any other matter or action as determined by ordinance adopted by the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government.

A detailed statement of the General Fund is included, with itemized revenues by source; expenditures; and other financing sources. The estimated revenue of \$530,929 includes ad valorem taxes of \$517,579 and state revenue sharing of \$12,500.

The expenditures of \$496,865 include ad valorem related fees of \$16,500; personnel reimbursements \$107,281; Supplies and materials \$7,850; other services and charges \$116,500; repairs and maintenance \$18,000 and \$230,734 debt service payments. The Veterans' Memorial District does not have any employees, however through a cooperative endeavor agreement, the Regional Military Museum Foundation provides for the operations and personnel for the museum.

On December 7, 2016 the board issued \$2.9 Million of Limited Tax Bonds, Series 2016 which also refunded the Series 2011 and a portion of Series 2013 issuances. Below, is the remaining debt service schedule, which reflects maturity of the bonds in March 2031.





La. R.S. 33:2211-2237; La. R.S. 39:1710

Local governing authorities may use provisions of R.S. 39:1710 to purchase materials and supplies on competitively bid state procurement contracts from a local vendor (situated within the boundaries of the local governing authority) by following procedures set forth in opinion.

Dear Mr. King:

You have requested the opinion of this office on the potential use of La. R.S. 39:1710 by municipalities and other local governing authorities in procuring materials and supplies with public funds.

R. S. 39 1710 was enacted by Act 779 of 1993, and provides as follows:

When a local governing authority purchases an item at the state bid price through a local vendor, the local governing authority may pay to the local vendor the costs for shipping, preparation, and delivery of the item, provided that these costs shall not exceed the state bid price by seven percent on purchases up to ten thousand dollars, five percent on purchases over ten thousand dollars and up to twenty thousand dollars, and three percent on purchases over twenty thousand dollars.

While the statute could have been more clearly articulated, it is clear to us that the legislative intent was to authorize "local governing authorities" such as municipalities and parishes to purchase materials and supplies which are available to political subdivisions on established competitively bid state procurement contracts from a vendor in the locale of the local governing

authority at the state contract price plus the percentages indicated in the statute for shipping, preparation and delivery.

In order to facilitate use of these provisions, we would advise that the following steps be taken by a local governing authority:

1. Determine from State Central Purchasing if there is a competitively bic state contract for the needed material or supply and obtain the State Contract Number and the specification for the item on state contract.

2. Contact a local vendor for the item to determine if he/she can provide the item meeting the exact same specification as the state contract item and obtain a written price quote for delivery of the item to the local governing authority. While the statute provides no definition for the word "local", it is interpreted in this context to mean a vendor situated within the boundaries of the governing authority seeking to make the purchase.

3. If the delivered price offered by the local vendor is within the percentages set forth in the statute for contracts of various values, a purchase order may be issued by the local governing authority to the local vendor, reflecting the state contract number, state contract specification, state contract price and the markup allowed to the local vendor for shipping, preparation and delivery of the item(s).

4. A copy of the local governing authority's purchase order shall be furnished to the State Central Purchasing Office for monitoring compliance with the provisions of R.S. 39:1710.

The statute in question is an exception to the otherwise sweeping requirement of R.S. 38:2212A(1)(a) that all purchases above the contract amount (presently \$10,000) made by a public entity with public funds be made by sealed bid pursuant to advertising. The procedures set forth above are intended to assure compliance with the letter and spirit of both the Public Bid Law (R.S. 38:2211-2237) and R.S. 39:1710.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the Terrebonne Parish Council, on behalf of the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government, that the 2022 Adopted Operating Budget be amended to recognize the necessary adjustment for the Parish Prisoners Fund. (Attachment G)

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the Terrebonne Parish Council, on behalf of the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government, that the 2022 Adopted Operating Budget be amended to recognize the necessary adjustment for the Criminal Court Fund. (Attachment K)

SECTION XII

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the Terrebonne Parish Council, on behalf of the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government, hereby authorizes Gordon Dove, Parish President, to execute any and all documents for these amendments as approved by the legal department.

SECTION XIII

If any work, clause, phrase, section, or other portion of this ordinance shall be declared null, void, invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional, the remaining words, clauses, phrases, sections, and other portions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect, the provisions of this ordinance hereby being declared to be severable.

SECTION XIV

This Ordinance shall become effective upon approval by the Parish President or as otherwise provided in Section 2-13(b) of the Home Rule Charter for a Consolidated Government for Terrebonne Parish, whichever occurs sooner.
