- 203-02-00100 Drainage Excavation: 1,690 Cubic Yards are being deducted from the original bid quantity, resulting in a final contract quantity of 51,540 Cubic Yards and a credit value in the amount of (\$15,210.00).
- 203-03-00100 Embankment: 2,847 Cubic Yards are being added to the original bid quantity, resulting in a final contract quantity of 18,852 Cubic Yards and an increase in value in the amount of \$22,776.00.
- 204-06-00100 Temporary Silt Fencing: 18.67 Linear Feet are being deducted from the original bid quantity, resulting in a final contract quantity of 4,081.33 and a credit value in the amount of (\$112.00).
- 701-03-01040 Storm Drain Pipe (24" RCP): This bid item is being removed from the contract in its entirety, resulting in a credit value in the amount of (\$6.000.00).

who agree as follows:

- A. <u>Original Contract</u>. The parties entered into that certain Agreement for Emergency Program Management and Monitoring Services filed for record with the Terrebonne Parish Recorder of Mortgages and Conveyances on July 14, 2021 at COB 2642, Page 20, Entry No. 1630973 (the "Original Contract"). The parties entered into Amendment No. 1 of the Original Contract on September 21, 2021, which is filed for record with the Terrebonne Parish Recorder of Mortgages and Conveyances on October 1, 2021 at COB 2648, Page 298, Entry No. 1635136.
- B. <u>First Renewal of Original Contract</u>. As authorized by Section 5.2 of the Original Contract, Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government hereby exercises its option to renew the Original Contract for its first one-year renewal term, commencing June 1, 2022, and ending May 31, 2022. Contractor acknowledges notice of this renewal.
- C. <u>Purpose of Amendment No. 2</u>. Contractor mobilized in the aftermath of Hurricane Ida. Owner requested demolition program management services from Contractor in accordance with Section 3.1 of the Original Contract.

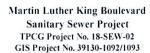

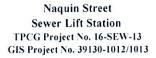

SECTION I

WHEREAS, the Parish has been approved a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, and the Fiscal Year 2021 COPS Hiring Program for Five Hundred Thousand dollars (\$500,000), and

WHEREAS, the grant will provide funding to hire four police officers for the Houma Police Department in an effort to improve the safety of all our Police Officers and the public.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Terrebonne Parish Council, on behalf of the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government, that the 2022 Adopted Operating Budget be amended for the Houma Police Department. (Attachment A)

SECTION II

WHEREAS, the Le Petit Theatre de Terrebonne, Inc. contributed \$10,000 toward the facility improvements of the Theatre, and

WHEREAS, the funds contributed will be used for the design and construction associated with the project.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the Terrebonne Parish Council, on behalf of the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government, that the 2022 Adopted Operating Budget and the 5-Year Capital Outlay Budget be amended to recognize the funding for the Le Petit Facility Improvements. (Attachment B)

SECTION III

WHEREAS, the Parish collected \$800,000 more than the 2021 budget for the one quarter cent sales tax, and

WHEREAS, this sales tax is for the Levee District, and

WHEREAS, the additional collections need to be recognized in the 2022 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the Terrebonne Parish Council, on behalf of the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government, that the 2022 Adopted Operating Budget be amended for the Levee District. (Attachment C)

SECTION IV

WHEREAS, Administration is requesting that the liquidated damages for the 1-1A Drainage project be recognized in the 2022 budget, and

WHEREAS, the liquidated damages of \$232,800 will go into the 1-1A Drainage project budget.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the Terrebonne Parish Council, on behalf of the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government, that the 2022 Adopted Operating Budget and 5-Year Capital Outlay Budget be amended for the 1-1A Drainage project. (Attachment D)

SECTION V

WHEREAS, Administration is requesting funding of \$75,925 for the East Side Police Substation and

WHEREAS, the funding source is from the Capital Projects Control fund for \$15,941 and the Public Safety Fund for \$59,984.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the Terrebonne Parish Council, on behalf of the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government, that the 2022 Adopted Operating Budget and 5-Year Capital Outlay Budget be amended for the Eastside Police Substation. (Attachment E)

SECTION VI

WHEREAS, Administration is requesting to amend the Operating Budget and Budgeted Positions, adding a full time Admin Coordinator II, Grade 106 and deleting an Admin Tech, Grade 101 for the Code Violation/Compliance Department, and

WHEREAS, the budgeted dollar for the change is \$8,400 for 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the Terrebonne Parish Council, on behalf of the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government, that the 2022 Adopted Operating Budget and Budgeted Positions be amended to recognize the necessary changes for the Code Violation/Compliance Department. (Attachment F)

The inspectors will not only be responsible for investigating complaints received by our office, but they will also be required to canvass their region & report/log violations to be processed by our office. This will cause an increase in complaints that will require additional clerical staff. The Admin Coordinator II, handles all the processing of complaints, violations, documentations, etc. The Admin Tech I, is more of a receptionist. The idea is to assign each Admin Coordinator II, to an inspector in order to handle the increase in daily task for each region. Therefore, I am asking that a budget amendment be done to add an Admin Coordinator II, instead of the Admin Tech I.
