SECTION VIII

R.S. 47:2336(C), this ordinance shall become operative, and the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government shall acquire full ownership of the properties herein.



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AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PERMANENT APPOINTMENT AND HIRING OF A CLERK AND THE HIRING OF AN ASSISTANT CLERK FOR THE TERREBONNE PARISH COUNCIL

SECTION I

WHEREAS, Tammy Triggs is currently working as the Temporary Council Clerk for the Terrebonne Parish Council; and

WHEREAS, Keith Hampton is currently working as the Temporary Assistant Council Clerk for the Terrebonne Parish Council; and
