The referenced project is nearing completion and as part of our project closeout process, All South Consulting Engineers, LLC (All South) reviewed our engineering fees in comparison to the effort expended to complete the project. During this analysis, we found that a significant amount of time during construction was spent resolving utility conflicts. These utility conflicts were unforeseen and required significant additional effort by All South.

LA One Call was contacted prior to surveying for the project in 2015, 2019, and again in January 2023. Several utility companies responded by marking their subsurface improvements. All South's survey team tied in those utilities, and these utilities were included in the plans and specifications for the project. Despite this due diligence, the existence and/or location of these utilities were significantly different from the LA One Call data, requiring additional effort to resolve these conflicts in the field.

Utility coordination efforts to date cost in the realm of \$30,584.57. We anticipate the project to be substantially complete by the middle of August, and additional coordination will likely be required before then. With this in mind, All South is requesting a Utility Coordination task be added to our contract as an Additional Service in the lump sum amount of \$50,000.00. Although this seems to be a large addition to our contract, \$9,000 can be moved from Topographic Survey and \$20,000 can be moved from Resident Inspection, meaning the increase to our contract would be \$20,000.

Additionally, we were requested to perform a Cost Reasonableness Analysis (CRA), for the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated waterworks (TPCW) waterline work that was performed to reroute conflict waterlines, for funding justification. In accordance with our original Engineering Agreement executed on March 13, 2014, this Scope of Work does not fall under standard

Construction Administration (CA), so we are requesting that our fee be adjusted to capture this additional service. The TPCW utility reroute work to date cost in the realm of \$90,000.00, for three (3) separate construction areas; the AC Waterline changeout at South Marie, the Waterline offset at South Alma Street and the Waterline Offset at North Alma Street. We anticipate the effort to provide the CRA will take approximately 22 hours based upon the attached man hour estimate, so we are requesting a Lump Sum fee of \$3,500.00 be added to our current contract.

In summary the changes to our contract, should TPCG approve this request, is as follows:

WHEREAS, Sec. 1-06 of the Home Rule Charter for the Parish of Terrebonne provides that parish government shall have the right, power and authority to pass all ordinances requisite or necessary to promote, protect and preserve the general welfare, safety, health, peace and good order of the parish, including, but not by way of limitation, the right, power and authority to pass ordinances on all subject matter necessary, requisite or proper for the management of parish affairs, and all other subject matter without exception, subject only to the limitation that the same shall not be inconsistent with the constitution or expressly denied by general law applicable to the parish; and

WHEREAS, the Terrebonne Parish Council and Terrebonne Parish Administration wishes to change the name of Southside Park to Hazel H. Naverre Park under Section 21-30(a) in honor of Mrs. Hazel H. Navarre.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Terrebonne Parish Council, on behalf of the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government, that the following be enacted:

SECTION I

Chapter 21, Article II, Section 21-30(a) of the Terrebonne Parish Code be amended as per the attached Exhibit A.

SECTION II

If any word, clause, phrase, section or other portion of this ordinance shall be declared null, void, invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, the remaining words, clauses, phrases, sections and other portions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect, the provisions of this ordinance hereby being declared to be severable.
