WHEREAS, the <u>Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government</u> , State of Louisiana, previously passed a resolution to become a participating political subdivision of the Authority in accordance with the Act; and
NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing authority of the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government, State of Louisiana, acting in such capacity;
Section 1. Approve the appointment of <u>Steve Crispino</u> to serve as a Director of the Authority for a term of two (2) years from the date hereof.
Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately and a certified copy hereof shall be forwarded to the offices of the Authority.
